In fact, when installed on its own, as your sole heating system, it can reduce your heating bills by up to 5% - not to mention staying eco friendly too!

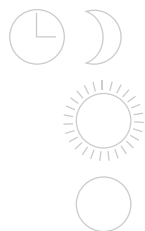

It's an environment in which every millimetre of every room you step into is heated with a totally relaxing, radiant kind of heat that gives you a great feeling of wellbeing, warming you through and through.

And, because it heats from the floor upwards, warming the body, yet cooling ever so slightly as it reaches head level, it's a heat that will always leave you feeling fresh and vibrant, with a complete sense of wellbeing.

The perfectly heated home environment just doesn't get any better than this, and it's brought to you in The Box by floorheater.

Some of the many other benefits and advantages of this brilliant new system include:

- A fast warm up time: The system's warm-water heating pipe runs directly under the flooring material, so adjustments made on the thermostat will have immediate effect, quickly bringing the room temperature up to that which is desired.
- Improved saleability of any home.
- A super low 12mm build height, allowing you to preserve ceiling height in any room.
- Hardwood flooring or tile can be laid directly on top of the system!
- Swedish made componentry - ensuring you the highest quality of system available.

Creating systems of 1 to 36 m² is easy with The Box by floorheater.

The Box is available in three different sizes of system - 6, 9 or 12 m² - each of which can be installed separately or combined as required to build larger systems of up to 36 m².

But The Box's flexibility doesn't end there... For example, say if you wish to create a mini system of 1 m², then it's just a case of ordering the 6 m² Box and simply cutting the plastic PEX pipe to size. With The Box you can do what you want to do!

But what's in a Box?

Well, inside every Box by floorheater, you'll find Swedish made componentry of the very highest quality, including easy to fit poly-panels with aluminium heat-diffusers, a flexible PEX water pipe with fittings, a roll of aluminium tape and the world's simplest installation manual - to take you step-by-step through the very fastest and easiest installation available.

The panels, which are only 12mm 'thin' and made of a tough poly material, have a preformed groove to slot the water pipe into, and a bonded 0.1mm foil coating that radiates heat with a class-beating maximum efficiency. They can be glued, screwed or stapled down on any existing floor or subfloor.

Also included in The Box system is a wall thermostat control and a high quality pump that creates the warm-water circulation through the system's pipe to heat the floor above.



The pump can draw its heated water supply directly from an existing hot-water boiler. Alternatively, where The Box is being installed to replace a conventional radiator system, the pump can be connected to the hot-water piping that originally served one of the removed radiators.

And, for connection of the pump to a combined number of Box kits, double and triple outlet manifold adaptors are available.



Then, as soon as you've finished putting down the panels, slotting the pipe into place and connecting it up to the pump, it's just a simple case of having a qualified plumber pressure test the system. Once this test has been carried out, you can then get straight on with the laying down of your choice of new flooring.

And that's really all there is to it...

Ordering The Box is even easier...

Getting ready to order.

Once you have measured your home and worked out the total m² area in which you want to install The Box system – excluding those areas of any room occupied by fitted furniture such as kitchen cabinets, etc - then go to the price list included with this brochure to work out the cost of your system.

If you're planning to lay tiles over the system.

The Box's panels can be nailed, screwed, stapled or glued to any kind of existing floor. However, where you are planning to lay tiles on top of the system, you must use glue to fix the panels down. floorheater recommends a particular floor glue for doing this.

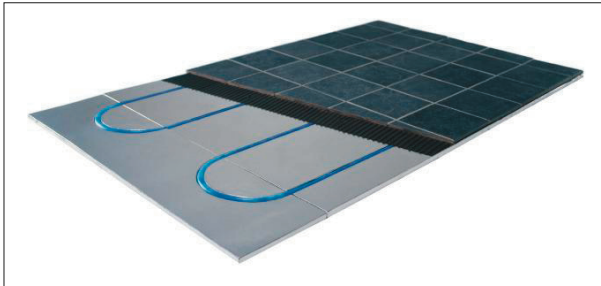
You can then lay the tiles directly on top of the system - providing they are larger than 10X10cm – but, again, you must use a special tile adhesive to fix them down.

You can order both types of special glue on the 'Box' website, or by phoning us directly.

Use the chart on the price list included with this brochure to see how much adhesive you'll need.

Thermostat option.

The pump supplied with each system comes with a standard wire-connected thermostat. If so desired, you can upgrade this to a wireless thermostat.
